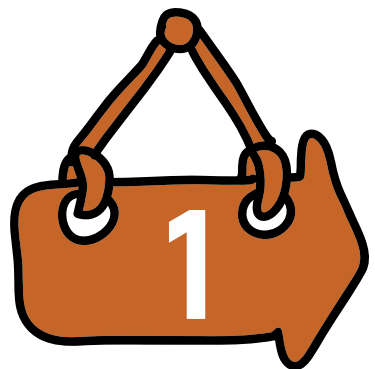
DIGITAL OPEN BADGES

Initially decide what you will badge and why you need to use a Digital Open Badge.

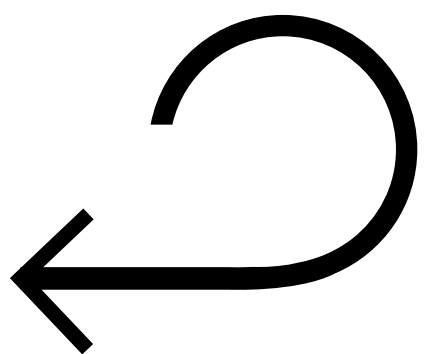
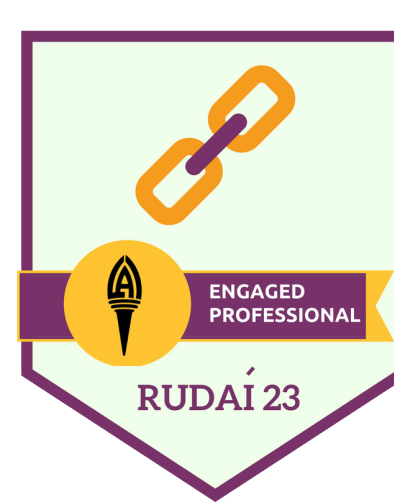
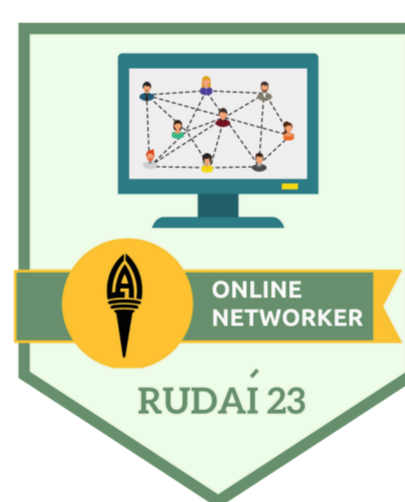


Choose provider & pay fee. We chose the Open Badge Factory and were sponsored by the LAI.



Create your badge: design the visuals & write the criteria behind it. This should state what the learner has to do to earn the badge and it must provide evidence of achievement.

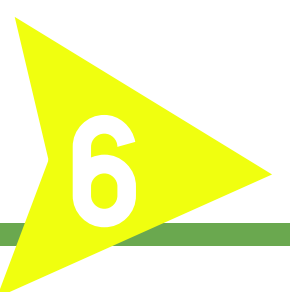
These are visuals of the 5 Digital Open Badges created for Rudaí 23

Evaluate applicants and award badges based on eligibility.



Learner accepts and receives badge, stores in Open Badge passport, and shares on their digital portfolio & on social media.
